*Japanese Style Papermaking.* 1994. produced by Timothy Barrett. Iowa City, Iowa: University of Iowa Center for the Book

Vol. I: Simple Equipment and Techniques. Shows supplies, equipment and procedure used to make a simple Japanese-style paper.

Vol. II: Traditional Equipment and Techniques. Shows the production of small sheets using traditional Japanese equipment, supplies and fibers.

Vol. III: Professional Equipment and Techniques . Shows the process of making Japanese paper from the harvest of traditional trees for their bark fibers to aspects unknown to Western papermaking.

Shawnee, KS: Kaw Valley Films. 1986 Examines the history of papermaking from ancient Egypt to the present day and describes the expanded use of paper during the last 200 years. Guides viewers in a step-by-step description of the paper production process and covers environmental issues related to papermaking.

*The Paper Mill* , 1993. Lubbock, TX: Creative Educational Video. Documents the process of making paper at Champion International Paper Mill, from the processing of logs and the preparation of pulp to the various finishing procedures which ready the paper for shipping and distribution.

Vol. I: Classroom Equipment and Techniques. An intermediate approach to making western handmade paper in a well-equipped classroom or personal studio workshop.
